**TO:** R66 owners, operators, and maintenance personnel

**SUBJECT:** Placards and Markings

ROTORCRAFT AFFECTED: R66 helicopters S/N 0004 thru 0051, 0053 thru 0058, 0060, 0064 thru 0066, and 0071.

**TIME OF COMPLIANCE:** Within next 150 flight hours or by 31 January 2012, whichever occurs first.

**BACKGROUND:** Some placards and markings were revised to comply with foreign certification requirements. Affected aircraft require one or more revised placards to match the required placards listed in the 1 September 2011 revision to the R66 Pilot's Operating Handbook.

## **COMPLIANCE PROCEDURE:**

- 1. a. For R66 helicopters S/N 0004 thru 0015: Order one KI-208-1 kit and install per <u>kit instructions</u>. Kit includes placards, updated pilot's checklist, & instructions.
  - b. For R66 helicopters S/N 0016 and subsequent (see Rotorcraft Affected): Order one KI-208-2 kit and install per <u>kit instructions</u>. Kit includes placards, updated pilot's checklist, & instructions.
- 2. Update helicopter's R66 Pilot's Operating Handbook (POH) to include 1 September 2011 revision (or subsequent). R66 POH updates are automatically mailed to Subscription J-, K-, and L-Class holders. The POH should not be updated until the placards have been installed.
- 3. Make appropriate maintenance record entries.

## **Approximate Cost:**

Parts: No charge for KI-208-1 or KI-208-2 kits if ordered by 31 January 2012.

Reference helicopter serial number.

Procure parts from any R66 Dealer or Service Center, or order directly from assigned RHC Customer Service Agent via email, fax, or phone.

Labor: 1.0 man-hour.
