Transparency in Supply Chain Disclosure

Robinson Helicopter Company, Inc., a California manufacturer, produces and procures almost all of the parts and components that go into our helicopters in the United States. We are strongly opposed to the use of forced, bonded, involuntary, prison or indentured labor. We continue to monitor and evaluate our supply chain to assess various compliance risks, including those related to slavery and human trafficking. Under the California Transparency in Supply Chains Act of 2010 we are required to disclose that we do *not*:

- verify, audit or require our suppliers to certify their products or services comply with local laws regarding slavery and human trafficking;
- require suppliers certify that materials incorporated into the product comply with the local laws regarding slavery and human trafficking;
- maintain internal accountability standards and procedures for suppliers or contractors failing to meet company standards regarding slavery and human trafficking;
- provide ongoing training for company employees and management with direct responsibility for supply chain management regarding human trafficking and slavery to find areas of improvement in eradicating slavery and human trafficking.
